ECONOMIC IMPACT

In 2023, HOM conducted several major construction projects, including building the first phase of the Bible College, advancing the Repatriote Youth Building, installing the Espwa Campus generator substation, and upgrading the Baryé Fé generator substation. 100% of purchasing was done in Haiti, creating economic impact in the following ways:



Since 2010, HOM has put in place **\$8.5 million** of new and updated construction providing over **187,000 days** of employment to Haitians.



REFLECTIONS FROM HOM'S FOUNDER

God is at work (Bondye ap travay) through your prayers and generous giving. Let me tell you how...

Across the three churches, we have close to 2,000 people in worship service every Sunday and 700 participating in Sunday School. Our church members are experts in how to "make a joyful noise" with songs, prayers, and praise echoing loudly in each sanctuary.

The four schools are thriving and are much in demand due to our strong reputation and excellent success rate. And our graduates are changing our society. They've become doctors, lawyers, engineers, bankers, nurses, IT professionals, schoolteachers, and more. The future looks very promising thanks to these young people.

The medical and dental staff are seeing more than 100 patients every day. Their expertise and service are very appreciated by the communities, as our clinic is one of very few whose doors are open these days.

Many of the graduates from our vocational school are working for different businesses in the area as well as outside of Port-au-Prince, and some have started their own private businesses.



That allows them to make a living for their families and become self-sufficient.

I know that many of you are impatiently waiting to see the day when you can resume coming to Haiti once again to serve, to see your friends, and to visit your sponsored students. I pray that day would come soon. In the meantime, please continue to pray and support the programs that we are offering to the people. God has a plan for Haiti, and we strongly desire to be part of that plan together with you.

Your generosity is making a big difference in Haiti and is changing the lives of so many. My prayer is that God will continue to bless our partnership to His honor and glory. As I always say, together we can do more, and the best is yet to come. Together, let's make 2024 the best yet.
