

# 2025 IMPACT REPORT

With God's provision and the support of old and new friends, HOM and Haitian operating partner MICECC provided opportunity and hope in 2025 in the following ways:

## EDUCATION

**1,969 STUDENTS** in grades Pre-K through 13 received a Christ-centered, academically rigorous education in our four schools.



## HUNGER RELIEF

**334,144 MEALS** were provided to school students and community members, addressing an urgent need as hunger rates increased in Haiti.



## HEALTH CARE

**21,580 ADULT AND PEDIATRIC PATIENTS** received essential medical and dental care in our community clinic; 37% of those treated were new patients.



## CLEAN WATER

**424,420 GALLONS** of free clean water were distributed, benefitting 137,140 individuals.



## SPIRITUAL CARE

**3,200 INDIVIDUALS** received God's word through weekly worship services, Bible study, and community outreach activities.

## BEYOND OUR CAMPUSES



**115 HOM** school graduates pursued university studies in diverse fields such as nursing, business, and engineering.



**303 WOMEN** received life-saving education & prevention lessons through our *Healthy Moms Healthy Babies* community health initiative.



**45 INDIVIDUALS** participated in our *Savings with Education* pilot project, which combines saving and lending with small business training.


